OUR PROGRAM

The Emory Human Health in Paris Program provides students the opportunity to experience the historical milieu that has set the standard for modern health care.

From the late 18th century to the early 20th century, Paris was the heart of scientific progress in health and established principles and approaches in modern medicine. Simultaneously, the cultural expression of medical concepts became a repeated theme, with anatomical depictions in art and sickness embodying characters in novels and operas.

Our program offers an integrated approach to health, humanities and liberal arts in two courses for a total of eight Emory credit hours. No previous French is required.



HLTH 385 (4CU) History of Medicine: How Paris Became the Center of Medicine in the 19th Century (Robert Gaynes, MD)

This course will fulfill ONE of the following:

- A Descriptive Analysis requirement for the Human Health major
- The Health and Humanities (HLTH 230) requirement for the Human Health major
- A Perspectives in Global Health, Category III requirement for the Global Health, Culture, and Society minor
- An Elective requirement for the Health Innovation concentration

HLTH 385 (4CU): French Perspectives on Health and Well-being (Michelle Lampl, PhD, MD)

This course will fulfill ONE of the following:

- A Mechanistic Understanding requirement for the Human Health major
- A Health Influences, Category C requirement for the Predictive Health minor
- An Elective requirement for the Health Innovation concentration

Eligibility

Emory and non-Emory students must:

- have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- be at least 18 years of age
- have completed one year of college
- be currently enrolled in a college/university
